charity to pick up. Still have 100 bags and various furniture.

- Mile of Money-August 17th or 18th
 - -Will contact printing company to print the signs and Kelly will contact the mall & King Soopers to confirm the date.
 - -Two weeks prior to the event(August 3rd), have some of the students to put up the signs.
- Broncos Fundraiser-Several families responded to the email
 - -Payment distribution options:
 - -Money should go to the student account only
 - -Percentage to general fund vs. students account
 - -\$94 per student and tips go to the general account
 - -Dates and times of training? No response from HR person
 - -Beginning June 8th and June 19th
 - -The events would not only Broncos games, but concerts, etc.
 - -Managers earn more money
 - -Commitment would go through December 29th, 2019.
 - -The volunteer must be 16 years or older. They can be a family member or friend, if the student is under 16 years old.
 - -We should backups, in case there is a volunteer has a family emergency

- -A minimum of 30 families would be necessary, to fulfill the the commitment.
- -The volunteers will not be able to watch the event.
