## 1. Summer Marching Band Rehearsals @Rocky Top Middle School

- We are doing a mini camp after Memorial Day, from 5/28, 5/29, 5/30, 6/5, 6/12 from 8:00 a.m. -12:00 p.m. and 6/17, 6/18 from 8:00 a.m. -2:00 p.m.
- We will do Marching the first few hours and break into music the second half.
- Each section will have time with an instrument specific coach, larger instruments groupings, and full band during the afternoon.
- Make these a priority, so you'll learn the music correctly and be prepared for marching season.
